## "THREE IN ONE"

The Trinitarian mystery comes from Jesus' own lips in today's gospel when He tells the Apostles to "baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son and of the Holy Spirit". We make the sign of the cross using the same words and in confession we are absolved with these words. We start our Catholic life with Baptism and end by receiving the Rite of Burial, all with the mystery of the Holy Trinity. At every Mass the Holy Trinity is present. In the Apostle's Creed we profess belief in the Trinity. The Holy Trinity is the central mystery of every Christian, although you will not find the word "trinity" in the bible. Today is the perfect day to invoke the God who created you, the Son who took on humanity and conquered death for you and the Holy Spirit who calls you to intimacy with the divine. The Holy Trinity desires you unceasingly, forgives you continuously and loves you abundantly. Will you allow the Holy Trinity to transform you from a life of mediocrity to a life filled with the grand purpose of renewing the face of the earth into resembling the face of God? This is your mission. This is why you were created, not to acquire goods, power or wealth but to believe, serve and proclaim. ## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

### First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40

Moses asks the people if they have ever seen anything as great as the actions of God. He reminds them that there is only one God and all people must keep his commandments. If the laws of God are kept, his people will prosper all their lives.

### Second Reading: Romans 8:14-17

Paul explains that through the Holy Spirit, we become children of God. As heirs of God we must be willing to suffer as Christ was if we are to share in his glory.

### Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

Jesus asks his disciples to go to other nations and teach others all that they have learned. He asks that these new followers be baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

## 2015-2016 CYO BASKETBALL REGISTRATION

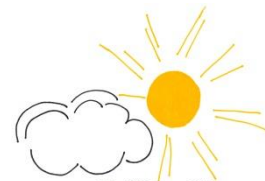

1. **Screening** of staff / volunteers.
2. Adults trained in **safe environment strategies** and signs of abuse .
3. **Code of conduct** enforced.
4. **Open Communication** between parents and staff / staff and children / children and parents.
5. **Parents** always **Welcome**.
6. Children educated in **right relationships & what to do if a relationship isn't right.**
7. All children treated with **Dignity and Respect.**
8. **Clear Rules and Expectations.**  
consistent reinforcement / consequences
9. **Adequate supervision of youth.**  
team approach—accountability—no 1:1 isolation
10. All **abuse** is **reported.**
