## "LAW OF LOVE"

All readings today deal with our relationship with God, each other, and His law. God's 10 Commandments were given to us as God's law. The first three commandments refer to our relationship with the Lord and the next seven deal with our relationships with others. They are easily understood, with no gray areas. God did not give us any loop holes. He did not say "Could you? or Would you?" but instead used "You will." In our own lives we give our children "do's and do not's." Why? Because we love them, want them to be happy and we are wise in the ways of the world; we see the big picture that youth does not see. We long to form their hearts to be pure hearts, loving hearts without malice. God's law, given from His pure love, is to form our hearts so they resemble His. Every action, good or bad, starts in the heart. Every choice we make has its roots in a heart of gold or a heart hardened by the wounds of life. Today's gospel calls us to take the time to examine our relationship with God, whose presence is found living inside of a pure heart, which not only hears the gospel but lives the gospel. Ask yourself: Are you just giving are you truly a partner with Christ who showed us the true meaning of God's law of love? ## TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8

Moses tells the people to always observe the statutes God has given them, without adding or subtracting from these laws. He reminds them that the law is just, and that any nation who heard their statutes would consider them a wise nation.

### Second Reading: James 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27

James discusses the gifts that God has given to all people and implores them to respond by welcoming the words of truth that can save them. He emphasizes that through good deeds and pure conduct, our faith in God is proven to him.

### Gospel: Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

The Pharisees observed some of Jesus' disciples eating without first purifying their hands and ask the disciples why they are going against their ancestor's traditions. Jesus responds that nothing from the outside can make a person impure. The only true evil, acts such as fornication, murder, and greed among others, come from within and make a person impure.
