## “CHRIST, YOUR TREASURE”

Has God been silent to your prayers? You're in good company with many of the Saints who suffered the “dark night of the soul” where Our Lord's presence was not felt and their faith was tested. St. John of the Cross and St. Theresa of Calcutta are just two examples of saints who stood firm in their faith despite many trials and hardships. Sometimes God remains silent in order for us to stretch, grow and experience our own depth of faith. Every believer will have their faith tested and sometimes more than once. You survive the test and find your faith may have been shaken, but on the other side of the pain comes strength. In today's gospel Jesus tells us “Do not be afraid” and continues last week's question: what possession do you most value? Jesus endorses storing up treasures for heaven and not earthly possessions; for “where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.” The Lord gives you a lesson today on preparedness which He expects from you, His followers. If you have been given much, then much is expected of you. Should you be called to meet the Lord today would you be ready? No blame game allowed, no excuses, no one but yourself to plead your case. Your life and your heart will attest to your worthiness to enter the Kingdom. Do you have a heart only for Christ? God has a heart for you, as Jesus tells us today, “Your Father is pleased to give you the Kingdom.” If you so desire heaven, then be vigilant in your love for God – be prepared! ## NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### First Reading: Wisdom 18:6-9

In this excerpt, the Israelites are reminded that they were warned before God sent an angel to slay the first born of the Egyptians. God called on them to have courage, and then rewarded them by punishing their enemies and leading them from captivity.

### Second Reading: Hebrews 11:1-2, 8-19

Faith is described as true belief even toward things we cannot see. Abram's faith in God was so deep that he wandered through a foreign land, convinced God's promise of a homeland was sincere. God honored his promise to give Abram many descendants, and was proud of the deep faith Abram and his people possessed.

### Gospel: Luke 12:32-48

Jesus encourages us to be prepared for his return at all times, for he will come when we least expect him. He tells of a master who entrusts his home to his servants, and fully expects them to be awaiting his return. In the same manner, Jesus can arrive at any moment and expects us to be prepared for his return.
