
“JESUS REMEMBER ME”

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Many of us believe we are the Kings and Queens of the universe and that the world revolves around “our” wants and desires. Today is the perfect time to enter into the process of self-reflection. Can you cure the deaf; do you make the crippled walk? Did you create the universe, nature and all that’s in it? CABARET SHOW

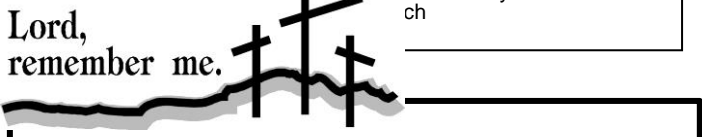
