CATECHISTS NEEDED

DRE responds to common hesitations

Parishioner - "I'm hesitant to become a catechist."

- Q. I don't know if I can handle a group of kids
A. Everyone is nervous teaching the first day or first few weeks. Children know how to behave because of being in school. They know acceptable behavior and what is not. Yes, kids act up at times. Children thrive when there are clear expectations and consequences for their behavior. If you are friendly, fair and firm with your students, classroom behavior is easier. Plus I'm here to support you every step of the way!
- Q. I'm not sure that I have anything to share. I'm not that holy. I'm just a regular person.
A. In addition to helping the students learn about God, you'll also help them know Jesus and develop that relationship through his Church. If you're thinking about being a catechist, then you might already have a good relationship with Jesus. You can share with the students how you got to this relationship and the struggles and joys that come with this relationship. As far as the holiness part – just look at the saints. They considered themselves regular people too, who happened to love God. Just like you!

PLEASE CONSIDER TEACHING RELIGIOUS ED
