WE HAVE A CHURCH MOUSE



"ETERNAL EMBRACE"

Today is the great feast of Corpus Christi, the body and blood of Christ. In today's Gospel, Jesus breaks the bread and offers it to his disciples on the eve of His death. It is by these same actions that his disciples will recognize him after the resurrection. The very first Christians understood the power of Christ's presence in the breaking of the bread by which they entered into communion with Christ and each other. God in His wisdom entrusted His bride, the Church, with a physical sign of His love and unity. He is giving us His body, blood, soul and divinity to consume, thereby, confirming at every Mass that we are children of God and heirs to His kingdom. Jesus calls himself the living bread of life come down from Heaven. *The bread which I give to the world is my flesh (John 6)*. Receiving the gift of the Eucharist is to receive the Lord Himself in an intimate union. Christ enters me allowing me to become part of His divinity. 

THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

(Corpus Christi)

First Reading: Exodus 24:3-8

Moses explained to the people the commandments he had received from God. Upon hearing them, the entire community immediately agreed they would do as God had told them. Moses then sacrificed young bulls and sprinkled the people with their blood, calling it the blood of the covenant they had made.

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:11-15

Jesus did not offer God the blood of sacrifices, but instead he offered up his own blood to cleanse all people of the transgressions they had committed under the first covenant with God. Christ instead brought a new covenant, which, if kept, would lead to eternal life.

Gospel: Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Jesus sent two of his disciples to prepare the Passover supper. During the meal he blessed bread and offered it to them saying, "This is my body." He then offered them wine and called it his blood, "the blood of the covenant, to be poured out on behalf of many."
