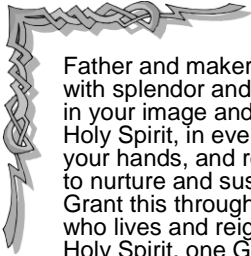
"GOD'S FINGERPRINT"

PENTECOST SUNDAY

First Reading: Acts 2:1-11
