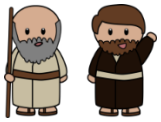

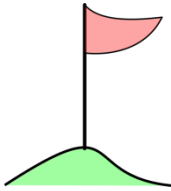
### GOD DOESN'T CALL THE QUALIFIED, HE QUALIFIES THE CALLED!

### “TRINITARIAN LOVE”

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Most of us find it easy to understand and believe that God is love but we have difficulty in understanding and believing in the Trinity. St. Patrick used the shamrock to explain the concept of three in one. You will not find the word ‘Trinity’ anywhere in the Bible, however you will find Jesus speaking about baptizing everyone in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, thereby describing the Trinity. God does not ask us to understand this mystery but he does ask us to have faith and believe in it. God also asks us to believe in His word, the Holy Scriptures. In today’s Gospel Jesus refers to God the Father as the source of all truth, and to the Holy Spirit who He says will teach you that truth. As you mature in your faith, God’s grace will fill you with understanding and wisdom. Your ‘faith’ will be the means by which you tap into God’s love, the righteousness of Jesus Christ by which you are justified and the guidance of the Holy Spirit into Eternal Life. The love between the three persons of the Holy Trinity is being poured out into your heart so as to empower you to live a holy life, as a testament of faith in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit: a life that glorifies the Trinity. ### THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

#### First Reading: Proverbs 8:22-31

God created Wisdom before he created the earth or the skies. This spirit stood beside God every day until the earth was complete, then “found delight in the people of the earth.” This indicates that the spirit of wisdom was later personified by Jesus.

#### Second Reading: Romans 5:1-5

Paul says that we are now at peace with God through our faith in Jesus. We also hope to see the glory of God. This hope will not leave us disappointed because of the love God has shown in sending us the Holy Spirit.

#### Gospel: John 16:12-15

Jesus tells the disciples that when he leaves them, a Spirit will help guide them to the truth. This Spirit will announce what he hears from Jesus, rather than speaking on his own. 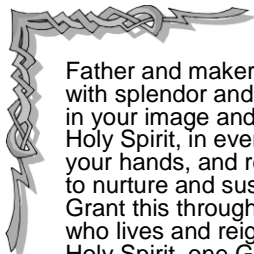
